
Spectator Safety NO-GO Area

Subaru Supports PFR Entrants



This year marks the 23rd consecutive year of participation in the Canadian rally championship (CRC) and the 15th year as a major series sponsor. In 1996, Subaru introduced a contingency program to help support all Subaru competitors. Since then, the program has been open to all Subaru vehicles entered in any of the six events within the national portion of the CRC series, regardless of home or country.

The contingency program consists of the following:

SIX -STAR PROGRAM

Awards the top Subaru finishers in every CRC national series event, regardless of their overall rally finish. First - \$1,000 down to sixth-place at \$500.

SUPER -SIX STAR PRIZE PROGRAM

Awards an additional \$1,000 to every

Subaru entry that finishes in the top six overall at any CRC national event.

STARTLINE FUND

Cash award to every Subaru entry that starts a CRC national rally, but places outside the top six Subaru entries. Pays \$250 to each Subaru starter.

PRESIDENT'S TROPHY

Recognizes the top Subaru overall in the CRC series. First place receives \$3,000.

YEAR -END CANADIAN CHAMPIONS AWARD

Subaru Driver winning the Canadian Championship in production 4WD receives an additional cash prize of \$1,500.

VOLUNTEER PRIZES

Best Vantage Points

Rally Service Park is open to the public both Friday and Saturday at Wagon West Travel Plaza, Airport Road. Please note that the forest spectator locations are remote and do not have services such as toilets or concessions, so make sure to plan ahead. Bring in everything you need, and leave nothing behind.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 3:


Come Downtown to Granite Avenue between 4:30 and 5:30pm to see the cars and meet the drivers as they prepare for the Ceremonial Start at 5:30pm.

"LILY LAKE" Night Special:

Access from 5:30pm to 6:30pm, then from 8:15pm to 8:30pm, then closed until 10:30pm. Cars pass three times: 7:30pm, 9:10pm and 9:45pm

From Downtown Merritt: proceed south along Voght Street. After crossing a small bridge, keep to the right (don't drive into Tolko Yard) and then turn Left onto Midday Valley Road. After 0.8km, continue straight ahead past Pooley Ave (no sign). Continue another 1.7km to the stage entrance at a cattleguard. The spectator point is 2.2km into the stage. If you pass the "5km" sign, you have gone too far. Once the course opening vehicles have started, all vehicle access in and out will be brief vehicle access in and out between the first and second runs of the stage.





SATURDAY OCTOBER 4:

Come to the service park at Wagon West Travel Plaza between 8am and 9:30am, to see all of the cars and meet the competitors. Throughout the day, the competitors will return here for their service breaks.

"MAB LAKE" Forest Special:

Access from 8:30am to 9:15am, then briefly around 10:40am. Cars pass twice: 10am and 11am

From Merritt: proceed along Hwy 5 north-bound. Take Exit 315 (Helmer Road) and turn left at the T-junction, then follow marshal's directions. The main spectator point is a 1km drive into the stage. If access is closed when you arrive, then there is also viewing at this location, but the best action is from the main spectator point. There will be brief vehicle access in and out between each run of the stage.

"COLDWATER" Super Special:

Access from 11:30am to 12:15pm, then closed until 2:30pm. Cars pass twice: 12:50pm and 1:45pm

From Mab Lake or Service: Take Hwy 5 south. Take Exit 286, and turn Left at the T-junction, towards Merritt. After 1.2km, turn

Left onto Coldwater Road. After 18km, turn Right onto Patchett Road. After 8km, turn Left onto Covert Place. Follow the signs to Coldwater Ranch and look for the Spectator Gate on your Right.

"COMSTOCK" Forest Special:

Access from 2:30pm to 5:30pm. Cars pass twice: 3:30pm and 4:30pm

From Coldwater spectator point, return to Merritt the way you came, then take Hwy 5 south. Take Exit 276, and turn Right at the T-junction, crossing under the highway. Follow the road up hill and look for the Spectator Gate on your left.


"HELMER LAKE" Forest Special:

Access from 5:30pm to 6:15pm, then closed until 8:30pm. Cars pass twice: 6:45pm and 7:50pm

From Merritt: proceed along Hwy 5 north-bound. Take Exit 315 (Helmer Road) and turn right at the T-junction, proceed under the highway to the west side, then proceed straight ahead trough the gate and follow marshal's directions to park in the open area on your right, just past the gate. There is good viewing 100m from the parking area, but the best viewing area is about a 900m walk into the stage.





The year 2007 started off with an interesting series of events. In late January, while travelling on Vancouver Island for work, I stopped to visit friends in Duncan. The following morning, I left Duncan Hospital's Emergency Department with a CD in my hand and instructions to go home and get my left kidney out.

This was my first rally experience of 2007. My friends and family 'rallied' around me

In early April, my left kidney was removed—a small cancer.

Pay Back Time

In May, a post on the Rover Landers. bc.ca forum by our WCRA member Tony Latham mentioned the need for volunteers to help with the Mountain Trials Rally. I had completed my Ham radio course in December 2006, now with kidney removed I was ready to 'pay back' for the 'rallying' help that I had received.

I volunteered to help at the Mountain Trials Rally and had a super time, meeting some amazing folks with a passion and dedication for this form of motorsport. I just knew I had to volunteer again.

I later experienced two more CT scans and a surgery to remove a lot of the lower lobe of my right Lung—another small cancer. Again, it was back to more 'rallying' support from family and friends, who were there for me.

Committed Volunteer and Driver

In 2014, cancer-free now for seven



years, I have experienced about six Pacific Forest Rallies as a volunteer—Road Closure Marshall; Ambulance Radio; Spectator Radio; Start Radio; Finish Radio. Plus any other areas in which I was asked to provide help.

In addition, I have also managed to compete in a local TSD Rally in a 2011 Subaru Outback—a wonderful car—purchased from Wolfe Subaru on the Langley Bypass, a dealership with an amazing group of supportive staff.

So far in 2014, I have rallied at 2014 Oregon Trails Rally; Olympus 2014 Rally; and the 2014 Idaho International Rally. In addition to these U.S. rallies, I will also compete in a Novice TSD out of the Mission area in a 1973 P6 2000TC Rover.

I am a volunteer at this year's Pacific Forest Rally, Invermere's Rocky Mountain Rally at the end of October, and the Big White Winter Rally, which will be held in early December 2014.

Rally volunteering holds a special place in my life and I owe so much to the great people who rallied around me when I needed it so much.


At 70 years of age, I hope to be able to volunteer a few more years.
