We are responsible for Competitor Safety

We are the last set of eyes on the road before the Competitors, to confirm instructions and signage;

We are responsible for Spectator Safety

We make certain Spectators are in designated areas only, and safely away from the course;

We are responsible for Staff Safety

We make certain there is sufficient staff to observe Spectators, and can warn of cars on route;

We are the Risk Management before the event

We make certain all possible safety measures are in place for Competitors, Staff, and Spectators;

We work closely with Sweep & EMTs. Event Organizers, and Operations, in Event Safety Management

We confirm that the Communications Net is intact

We check "Comms" at all points along the route, implementing additional equipment as needed;

We confirm that timing controls are functioning properly before First Car

We check that all personnel are in place and properly trained in timing functions;

We bring our three-car team to your event with experience and wisdom to assure that the above elements are completed before the First Car is on the stage.

Our team is comprised of former stage rally drivers, former stage rally co-drivers, a former stage rally crew-chief, and we have HAM radio operators in every car.

Our team has comprehensive knowledge of A.R.A., NASA, R-A, and C.A.R.S. Rules

Team members are also current navigational rallyists and organizers, giving insight to timing of the event and clarity of route instructions.
